

EuFood-STA Centre developed a free and open access Digital library for the food sector

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The aim of the Food-STA centre (<https://www.food-sta.eu>) is to boost innovative education & training for students, teachers and food professionals targeted towards industry needs. Accordingly to food industry priorities, training materials, in different formats, are being developed and collected. A Digital Library was made available online (<https://db.iseki-food.net/digital-library/output>) integrating inputs from the Food-STA project, the ISEKI-Food Network (<https://www.iseki-food.net/>), the TRAF00N Project (<https://www.trafoon.org/>) and SEA-ABT Project (<https://www.sea-abt.eu/>), as well as from other sources. This database offers a collection of digital teaching materials, such as webinar recordings, developed within the EuFood-STA project and also other materials, like eBooks, videos, pictures, diagrams, presentations, serious games, simulation tools and research articles. In total, 1265 records are present to date in this free access EuFood-STA Digital Library, covering the main topics of food sector. Although the database is ready and online and maintained by the ISEKI-Food Association, the Food-STA consortium is continuing to update and extend this Digital Library permanently.
