CATALYSE aims to develop a **Community of Practice (CoP)** for innovation in **food safety** prioritizing interconnectivity, and offering high-quality information, education, and training.

CATALYSE methodology

- 1- Identify relevant networks, organizations, industries, actors as stakeholders (SHs);
- 2- Design surveys, structured interviews and interactive sessions to collect and analyze data to understand the main needs and interests of SHs;
- 3- Data analysis to understand the main priorities in the field for SHs;
- 4- List of high-potential innovations and searchable knowledge database;
- 5- **Vivid Community of Practice (CoP);**
- 6- High quality education program;
- 7- Better connections between end-users and innovators;
- 8- **Improved uptake of innovation in Food Safety.**



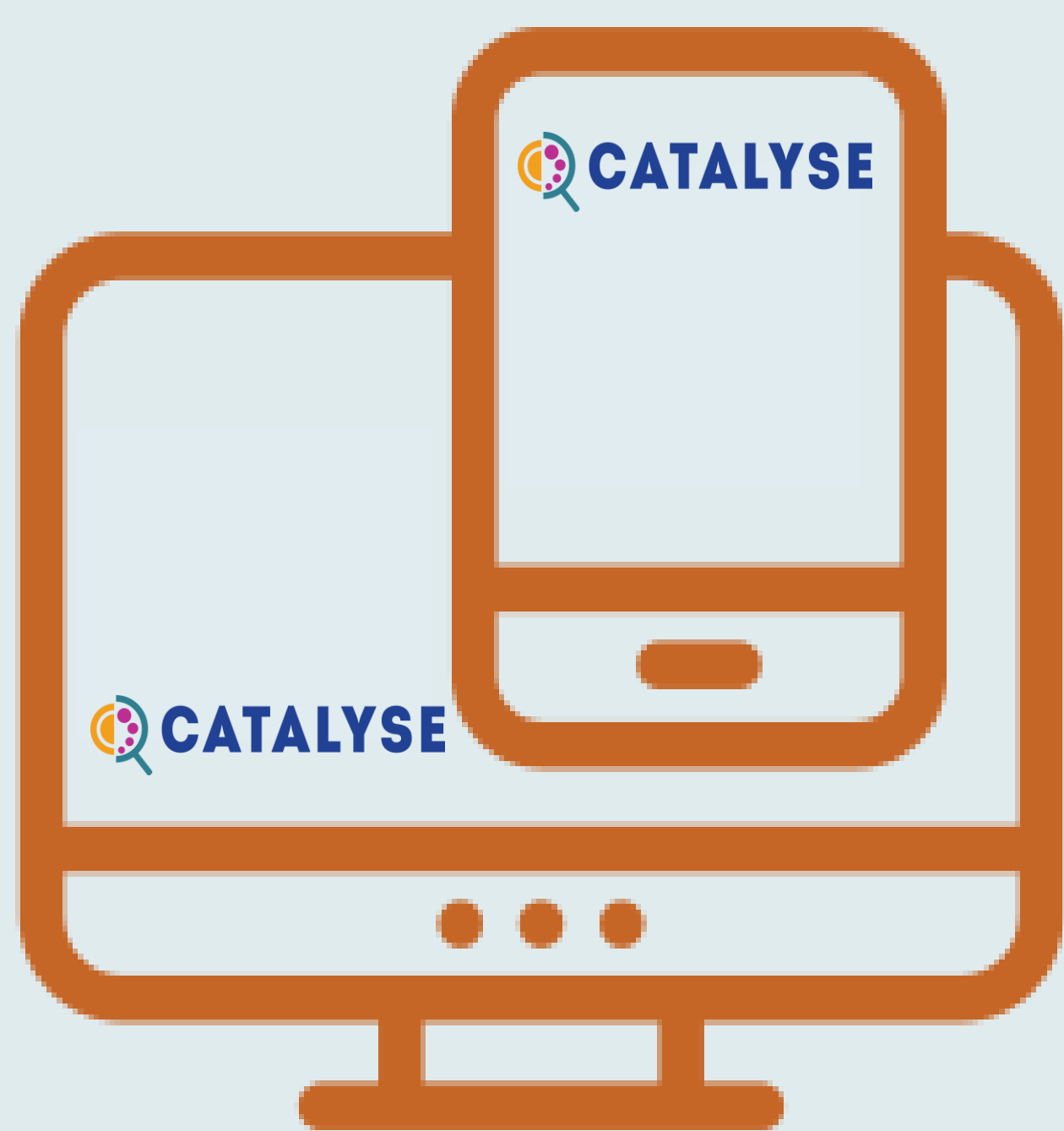
Community of Practice

“Communities of Practice (CoPs) are groups of people who share a concern or a passion for something they do and learn how to do it better as they interact regularly.”

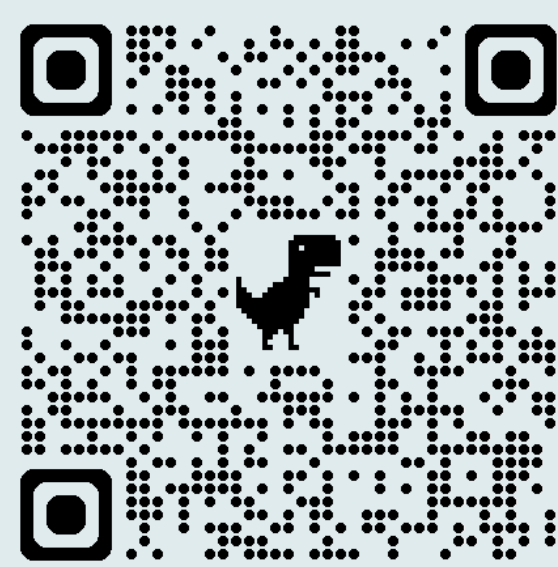
